We encourage our parents to visit their child's classroom throughout the year. Please make arrangements in advance with your child's teacher. We ask that parents not bring young children when visiting their child's classroom. Children not enrolled at the school must be accompanied by an adult 21 years old or older when visiting school.

When visiting our school, please remember the following:

- You **MUST** come to the main office to sign in. This is an Aurora Public Schools District security policy to keep our students safe.
- Effective immediately, when obtaining a visitor's badge, we will require that you leave either your license or car keys at the main office until you check out.
- Animals at school are restricted by board policy. Since we cannot predict the behavior of animals around large groups of children, we ask that you not bring animals on the school campus, even when dropping off and picking up students.

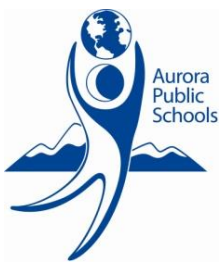
Cafeteria Rules

We ask that students do not bring food from home when obtaining a hot lunch from the cafeteria. However, when bringing a sack lunch from home, we request the following:



- **Avoid foods like hot cheetos, chips, cookies, crackers, gummy snacks, etc.**
- **If these items are packed in a sack lunch please assure that it is in a single serving and not a full size bag/package.**
- **No soda. We welcome bottled water, Capri sun, or other boxed drinks. Sodas are too high in sugar and make it difficult for students to focus in the afternoon.**

Outside line up and recess weather guidelines

We highly suggest that every child is dressed and prepared for the unpredictable Colorado weather. Current weather conditions will determine whether or not students will play outside.
